We are very excited about the upcoming "Days at the Docks" and appreciate your interest in attending our event.

Festival Dates: April 24 and 25, 2010

Booth Space: 10' x 10'

Booth Fee: \$100.00 for the weekend (*\$150.00 after April 1, 2010*)

Application Deadline: April 1, 2010

Business Hours:

- Saturday: 9:00 AM till 5:00 PM
- Sunday: 9:00 AM till 4:00 PM

You are expected to be open for business for the full hours both days.

If you are not prepared to stay till the posted time, then another show might be best for you.

Set-Up and Tear-Down

- Check-in will begin on Friday at noon. (At this time you may begin setting up your booth, tables, etc.)
- *If you would like to be able to set up on Friday, please note that on the application.*
- Security will be provided for Friday and Saturday night.
- Artists/Crafters vehicles are to be removed from the festival grounds before 8:30 am Saturday and Sunday
- Our insurance policy prohibits vehicles from being brought into or leaving the festival area during the posted hours.
- You may hand truck your goods in and out if you need to during the posted times.
- After the posted times vehicles will be allowed in if and when the Holden Beach Police Dept deem it safe to do so.
- There will be no refunds due to inclement weather.

Craft Items:

- Only handmade crafts and individual artwork are allowed in the show. Commercially manufactured items, computer generated materials, consignment tables, publications and political pieces are not allowed. No weapons, real or facsimile, or items that could be perceived as weapons will be allowed. If you have any questions on this please contact us prior to sending in your application.
- A photo of your craft or art is required from all applicants.
- The Festival Committee has final approval on who will be accepted.

Application and Fees:

- Booth Space: 10' x 10'
- Booth Fee: \$100.00 for the weekend. (*\$150.00 after April 1, 2010*)
- Applications with your check or money order must be received by April 1, 2010.
- Make check or money order payable to "GHBMA".
- Your check will be your receipt until you receive your official space assignment.
- The space assignment will not be sent to you until after April 1, 2010.
